

2010 Milt Minor Award



The Milt Minor Award is given to the Oregon Manufactured Housing Association's "Person of the Year". The members of OMHA vote for the person to receive the award. The Award is named after Milt Minor. Before he passed away, Milt was the General Manager of Fleetwood Homes of Washington. He was a long time member of OMHA and was one of the founders of the NW Pride program. He was also one of the original manufacturers to agree to build homes to the "Super Good Cents" energy efficiency standards.

The members of OMHA voted for Dick Bonheimer to receive the award because of his many contributions to the Industry. Dick has served on the OMHA Board of Directors since 2005. He agreed to serve an unprecedented fourth(4th) term as OMHA President. He serves on the Golf Committee. He also serves on the NW Pride Board and regularly attends their meetings in Seattle.

He also attends meetings of the Manufactured Housing Coalition. The Coalition is a group that represents "park" owners and tenants. They meet monthly at the OMHA Office and develop compromise legislation to promote the common interests of landlords and tenants.
